We responded to their requests for assistance, building hope and resilience. We traveled to many international cities providing training, counseling and consulting.

37 organizations partnered with us to receive training, counseling and consulting help

2,500 individuals received training as part of an in-person workshop or webinar

More than 1,000 hours of psychological care were provided remotely to those with no other resource

800 individuals received assessments to prepare them for challenging deployments

Over 1,500 individuals took the Headington Institute Resilience Inventory (HIRI) this year. This global data helps us understand the best ways to support humanitarian staff and first responders

We provided 330 hours of consultation to managers, equipping them to respond to a broad range of staff care needs and emergencies

More than 166,000 online visitors used our website, blog, YouTube videos, Facebook, and mobile app to support their well-being and trauma recovery

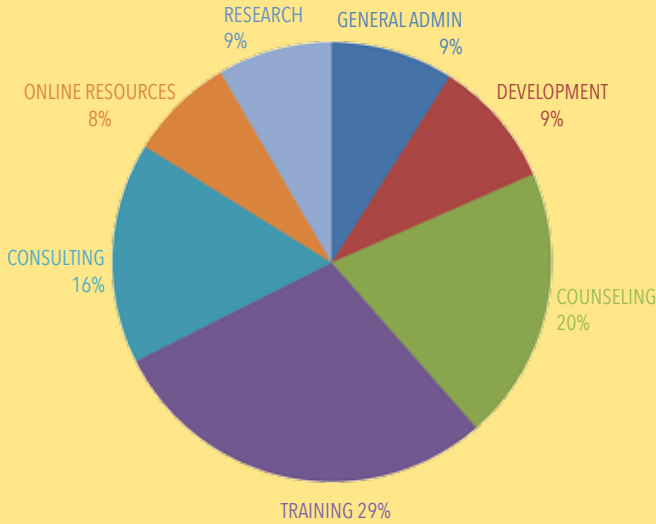
